- Three paid registrations for the ORA Winter Reading and Writing Institute to be held February 10-11, 2012.
- Free one-year ORA memberships or renewals for the ENTIRE certified school staff.
- An invitation to present at the 57th IRA Annual Convention in Chicago, IL, April 29-May 2, 2012. (not required)

Criteria:

- All public and private elementary and secondary schools are eligible if the school has at least one IRA member.
- The school must apply with its entire reading program, not just one segment, such as Title I, library/media.
- The application form must be signed by the chief school officer, e.g. the superintendent.
- The winning program should serve as a model for other schools and teachers.
