There are FIFTEEN \$200 Grants Available!

- Only current, fully paid-up members of the Oregon Reading Association are eligible to receive these grants.
- A one-page proposal (which cannot be returned) should be submitted, telling how you would use the \$200 grant money to promote literacy in Oregon. **Please include a title for your project.**
- The judges will use the following criteria in making their decisions:
 - The clarity and completeness of the proposal.
 - The extent of the project's impact.
 - Its value in promoting literacy.
 - The use of effective literacy practices.
 - The sustainability of the project after special grant funding.
- The winners will be asked to complete an evaluation form and should be willing to share their projects with their local reading councils and possibly at the Oregon Reading Association Annual Conference.

Judging will be by members of the ORA Executive Board and others.

Winners of the grants will be notified by December 15, 2008.
