There are TEN \$200 Grants Available!

- Only current, fully paid-up members of the Oregon Reading Association are eligible to receive these grants.
- A one-page proposal (which cannot be returned) should be submitted, telling how you would use the \$200 grant money to promote literacy in Oregon.
Please include a title for your project.
- The judges will use the following criteria in making their decisions:
 - The clarity and completeness of the proposal.
 - The extent of the project's impact.
 - Its value in promoting literacy.
 - The use of effective literacy practices.
 - The sustainability of the project after special grant funding.
- The winners should be willing to share their projects at the state conference and/or for their local reading councils.

*Judging will be by members of the ORA Executive Board and others.
Winners of the grants will be notified by December 15, 2010.
